

Healthy funding

LOGAN students are jumping, swinging and kicking their way to good health, thanks to Member for Rankin Craig Emerson.

All 42 schools in the electorate will receive \$100 in sports equipment of their choice as part of Dr Emerson's quest to encourage local school children to head outdoors and be active.

Dr Emerson said it was a serious problem when about 25 per cent of children in Queensland were overweight.

"We also know that physical inactivity is a significant cause of deaths considered 'preventable' in Australia," Dr Emerson said.

"Eating well and being physically active promotes a happier, healthier lifestyle.

"I'm more than happy to contribute to that goal in any way I can."

Dr Emerson is providing the funds himself, following on from previous years when he donated items to school parents and citizens' associations.

So far, Calvary College has received eight soccer balls and a netball, Crestmead State School has received a mix of bouncing balls, Shailer Park State School has re-



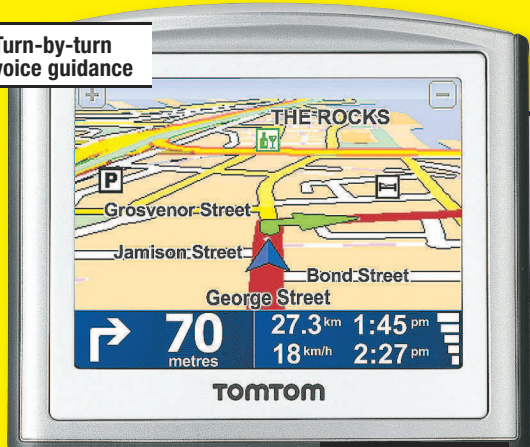

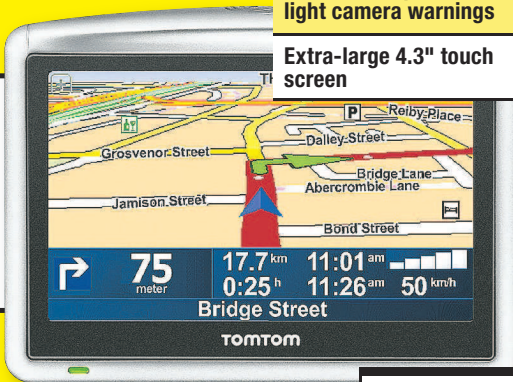

The Queensland Government has released draft planning options for improving 6.9km of the Pacific Motorway from Daisy Hill Road at Daisy Hill to the Logan Motorway at Loganholme also known as Section C of the Pacific Motorway Transit Project (PMTTP).

Main Roads is inviting community feedback on the draft plans during April and May 2008. You can have your say on the draft plans for Section C by visiting a display or contacting the project team.

The project will provide for alternative and sustainable transport including buses, car-pooling and cycling. The improvements include widening the motorway for new transit lanes, bus lanes and the V1 Bikeway.
